Dear Bazell,

I am slowly digging my way through my heap of unanswered letters. Among others I found one from you. As it was not dated, I may assume that I got it yesterday. -

You asked me whether I had seen your answer to Spitzer. - I have neither seen Spitzer's attack nor your answer. Where has it been published?

I had hoped to meet you in Oslo. But perhaps you were on your way from Turkey to London. The congress was much better than the one in Paris, and it is also said to be much better than the London congress. It was well organized, and the weather was fine, and there were many nice people. As for the communications and discussions, the kind this part less essential, as I generally fall asleep in the middle of it, and it is much better to read it afterwards. But there were some good communications.

I went almost directly from India to Oslo. I do not remember whether I have told you that I was invited to teach at the linguistic Summer school in Mehra Jan (it is a Rockefeller programme, sponsored by the Linguistic Society of India). I was there for in May and June, and in July I travelled about in India. - It was very hot, too hot for me, and I got very closely acquainted with medical science in India but all the same it was very interesting, and I liked the people very much.

Martinet has been here in September, giving lectures on Indo-European Phonology. It was somewhat disappointing. He was better when he was young.

I met Coseriu at the Congress. He is very intelligent, but he knows it too well.

I hope you like your new job.
