I sent the other day an offprint of a few "structural notes", of which probably only the fifth and sixth may interest you. In case you cast it in the wastepaper-basket as "old cabbage" I'd like to say that the relational definitions in (v) are not the same as in my old letters; it had occurred to me afterwards that I was making the mistake of which I've so often accused the glossematists, that of defining terms by single criteria instead of by a "syndrome" or convergence of criteria.

By the way you cannot have agreed so fully with my article in the Archivum if you hold there is any problem about ph etc. being single phonemes. They are not single phonemes in their own right, but belong there (like the vocative among the cases) by virtue of "configurational pressure". (Incidentally Lotz thinks the Archivum article to be nonsense, and I imagine all Americans would agree with him except Sapir --and he, alas!, is dead.
