Dear Dr. Hjelmslev!

Your letter of September 22nd  
arrived yesterday and I hasten to  
reply.

Elizabeth has written of you  
and your wife in her letters to the  
family, so your name is not strange  
to me, and this work on which you  
and Hans Jørgen collaborated has  
also been mentioned by her.

We are very pleased to learn of  
this opportunity for H. J. to prepare  
for a position on the staff of the  
University of Copenhagen and I  
am sending your letter on to him  
by air at once: I know they will  
both be delighted to receive it. From  
three to six weeks are required for  
air mail to reach Cairo from here  
and ordinary mail is often three  
months on the way.

They grieve over their inability to communicate directly with their friends and loved ones in Denmark, but it is still possible for me to act as a "go between"; and I am very happy to be able to do this for you also.

Hans Jørgen and Elizabeth are not in the U.S., but in Cairo, where they arrived last fall after spending a few weeks in Palestine, living in Tel Aviv and they were there when that city was bombed in September. They do not enjoy living in Cairo, and were very happy to be back in Palestine for the Holiday Courses again this summer. In Tel Aviv they have a pleasant flat with kitchen and they can do a bit of cooking for themselves, which they both enjoy.

Last winter Elizabeth taught in the American University in Cairo and she hoped to do the same again when they returned in September.

We have been working through our State Senators to secure papers for Hans Jørgen's admission to this

country: it is however a long and tedious process. We were very pleased indeed when we learned that they had received the Certificates which were sent from Denmark for H. J. - and they now have those to present should there be an opportunity to use them.

We are naturally very anxious about our dear ones, but we have a wonderful all powerful Father in whom we trust and they have been committed to His loving care and keeping.

Perhaps it is His plan that they go back to Denmark, rather than come to America, now that this opportunity is opening for them: they could then have little Anne again.

I hope that you know Our Father: in these dark and troubled times He is our only Refuge - Psalm 46 -
