Mood

in Mood, is the dynamic one: 'expansion' : 'concentration', comprising two elements: 3:a, 'expansion', and \neq 3:A, 'both expansion and concentration'; the opposition may be utilized as one of 'remoteness in time, and/or weak intensity' : 'immediacy and/or strong intensity' as in the case of the persuasive (3:a) : the imperative (3:A), or the sense may be 'duration' : 'instantaneity' as in the case of the associative-subjunctive (3:a) : the subjunctive (3:A).

The three dimensions are functionally defined as simplex categories (metaglossemes) of combination: {1} combines with {2:3}, {2} with {1:3}, and {3} with {1:2}; their correlative indices consequently cannot be ascertained, and they must be defined as contentious, which, in a correlation of three, means (a)* (b)** (γ). Together they make up the category of Mood which, as we have seen (§), is defined as :A (species: exponent)!A (type: extense) :A (subtype: heteronexual neric direction).

The subtypic category of Mood thus consists of three metmorphemes, manifested as nine morphemes, and utilized as twenty-four units. This analysis can be conveniently summed up in the following table:
