But I still very much hope that I shall have some word from you about a new edition. It is badly needed, and I am hard put to understand your silence. I can understand that you may not wish to review at this time all the changes I suggested - perhaps none of them. But is there not some way in which the Prolegomena can again be made available in English?
